Program participants should be able to do the following, independently or with the assistance of a companion or adaptive equipment:

- ? Stay alert and focus attention during instruction
- ? Understand and follow directions and instructions to avoid and/or manage risks
- ? Tolerate exposure to the natural elements, including sun/temperature for 3 hours
- ? Perform self-care including maintaining nutrition and hydration, personal hygiene, and managing existing medical conditions away from built facilities
- ? Be able to identify and recognize environmental risks, including but not limited to, falling objects/rocks, loose rock and unstable surfaces, steep and uneven terrain
- ? Engage in service-learning projects such as building, digging, lifting, painting, construction, and clean-up for 3 hours
- ? Wear all protective gear recommended or required for the work/service, including gloves and footwear
- ? Work responsibly and reliably with minimal supervision and/or on a team
