

# Essential Eligibility Criteria

## ***Sgt. York Monthly Volunteer Day***

Program participants should be able to do the following, independently or with the assistance of a companion or adaptive equipment:

- Stay alert and focus attention during instruction
- Understand and follow directions and instructions to avoid and/or manage risks
- Tolerate exposure to the natural elements, including sun/temperature for 4 hours
- Travel over and negotiate varied terrain for 1 mile in an estimated 30 minutes
- Travel over trail for 30 minutes without sitting
- Manage personal care in remote environments without access to electricity and/or running water
- Carry at least 32 ounces of water
- Engage in service-learning projects such as building, digging, lifting, painting, construction, and clean-up for 2-4 hours
- Wear all protective gear recommended or required for the work/service, including but not limited to protective eyewear, face mask or shield, gloves, helmet, footwear
- Work responsibly and reliably with minimal supervision and/or on a team
