

Essential Eligibility Criteria

Henry Horton State Park

Wetland Hike

Program participants should be able to do the following, independently or with the assistance of a companion or adaptive equipment:

Manage personal care in remote environments without access to electricity and/or running water, including hydration

Tolerate the elements for one (1.5) hour, including heat/cold, sun

Be able to identify and recognize environmental risks, including loose rock, uneven terrain, and potentially hazardous animals and insects

Travel over and negotiate mostly flat, packed soil and loose rock terrain for one and a half (1.5) miles in an estimated one (1.5) hour without sitting

Be able to travel along a slight elevation for about 50 feet
